



2012 Scholarship Program & Application

The Minnesota State High School Clay Target League (MSHSCTL) is offering one \$1,000 scholarship to a student athlete that is participating in the 2012 season.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

1. To provide financial assistance for a student that is continuing his/her education after high school.
2. To reward students seeking a career in environmental sciences or conservation industries.

QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible for the \$1,000 scholarship, the shooting sport student athlete must meet the following criteria:

1. Student athlete must be a member of a participating MSHSCTL team in the 2012 season.
2. Student athlete must be a high school senior graduating in 2012.
3. Student athlete must demonstrate an interest in furthering his/her education in the field of environmental sciences and/or conservation of our natural resources.
4. Student athlete must adhere to all school district rules, policies and requirements concerning student activities including, but not limited to, attendance, conduct, scholastic standing and other eligibility requirements.
5. Athlete must submit all necessary documentation before May 1, 2012
